1	The JLFT successfully operated the toilets and they were, and are, a great asset to the town. The toilets should be handed over either FOC or for a nominal sum
2	Excellent, JLFT can look after them better than SBC can.
3	I am happy for the transfer to go ahead to JLFT. In the last period the toilets being open has increased the tourist traffic at this end of the Town.
4	As long as the toilets are kept open and available at all times and at no cost to the public then I do not care who operates them. We need basic toilets for a basic bodily function to which we are all subject. There is no argument for closing toilets but there is an argument for having more basic [not heated and without hot water] facilities so that we can all have our most basic needs met. To be closing all these vital toilets because the council cannot afford to keep them open is just disgraceful. The population is increasing, as is leisure time. We need more toilets. The tour buses stop at this car park and the passengers have an immediate need, on disembarking from their bus, to visit a toilet after travelling for several hours.
