

Why are we making changes?



The amount of money the Council is given is going down



The Council must have enough money to support people who need help

The Council wants to change how much some people pay for social care

This is so the Council is able to give help to people who need it

How your care may be provided



How much you pay for your care



How extra care housing will be charged



How extended short breaks are charged

A financial assessment will decide how much you have to pay for your care and support.

<u>Care</u>



What do we do now?

We provide you with the care that you need based on an assessment. We listen to you and your families views on how to give that care



How is this changing

If someone wants a more expensive type of support, the council will only pay the cost of the council assessed care





Short breaks



What do we do now?

We provide short breaks for up to 4 weeks

How will this change?

People that stay **longer than 4 weeks** will be financially assessed to see what they can contribute to their care

Extra Care Housing and Housing with Care



What do we do now?

We charge a set fee for extra care housing and housing with care, no matter what your level of care is

How this is changing

We will charge for your care needs based on three levels

Level 1 – up to 12 hours a week

- Level 2 13 21 hours a week
- Level 3 over 21 hours a week

The amount you pay will be based on a financial assessment

Paying for your care



What do we do now?

We look at all your savings, outgoings and income to see what you would pay towards your care



What is changing?

If you have savings over £16,000 you will be asked to pay for all of your chargeable care





Paying for care (taper rate)



What do we do now? We assess how much people can afford to pay



What is changing? We are asking people who can afford to pay, to pay more
